Created by Broadway and Cirque du Soleil artists, LYRA is a unique combination of traditional musical theater and a European circus aesthetic. LYRA uses circus arts, not as a spectacle, but, along with music and dance, as a means by which to advance the story. A beautiful, innocent young girl, a tragic clown and an omnipotent magician set the stage for a tale of love, sacrifice, dreams and escape.





THE STORY

Unlike its more commonly known adaptations, the original LITTLE MERMAID is quite dark and deals with very deep themes – the nature, and importance of the human soul and the power of sacrificial love. LYRA stays thematically true to the original narrative and, given the nature of it being a magical, otherworldly fairy tale, it provides the perfect story whereby to utilize a circus vocabulary.

LYRA takes place in a dustbowl era circus run by Mr. Wednesday - an omnipotent illusionist using the circus as a front to collect people's souls. Lyra, the young, intelligent singer is the only member of the circus who did not trade her soul to be there. Born into this magical world, her only wish is to "run away and join real life." So when a young man provides her first hope of escape, she makes a deal with Mr. Wednesday to earn her freedom, leaving behind her one friend, the clown Pierrot, and the only world she has ever known. But, intent on winning Lyra's soul, Mr. Wednesday begins a diabolical game that will test the power of love and forgiveness.





SHOW REQUIRENTS

LYRA can be performed with a minimum cast of ten and a band of five (Keyboard 1, Keyboard 2, Drums, Bass, Guitar). This is a piece that requires circus elements - (Aerial Hoop, Silks, Tight Rope, Acrobatics, Clowning, Illusion/Magic) and needs to be performed in a space with a grid high enough to accommodate those apparatuses.

The piece can be paired down (in "Les Sept Doigts De La Main" fashion), or large form spectacle. All cast members need to have a varied skill set - with specific requirements for each character (Lyra must sing, act, dance, perform aerial and minimal acrobats, Pierrot must act, sing, play the ukulele and be a physical comedian, etc.)

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
